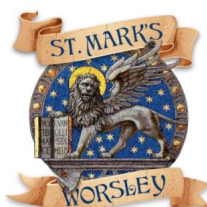

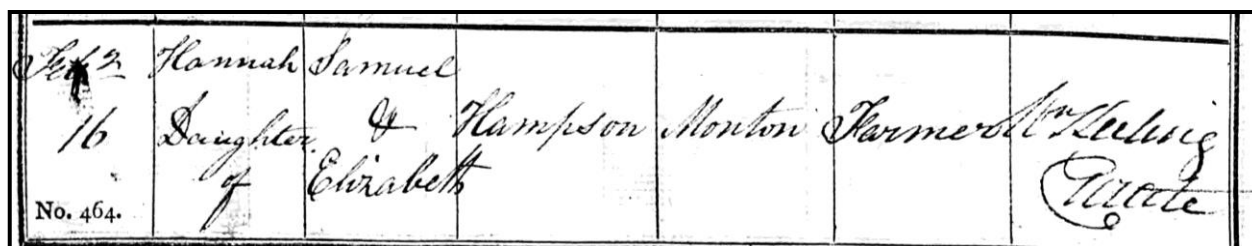

**Hannah Hampson** was born on 17 December **1822** and was baptised at St. Mary, Eccles, the older sister to James Hampson (q.v.), farmer at Vicars Hall, Boothstown.

This census was taken seven years after they had married. Clearly, Hannah was not at home on the day the census was taken, but it is a mystery as to where she was. Richard was listed as married and Hannah reappeared in the 1871 census! However, no record has been seen that places her somewhere in 1861.

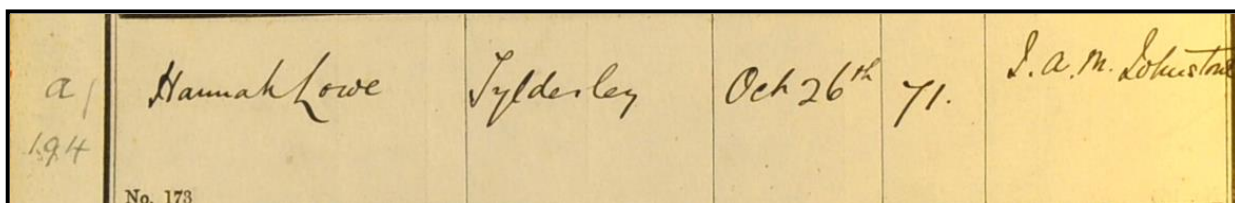

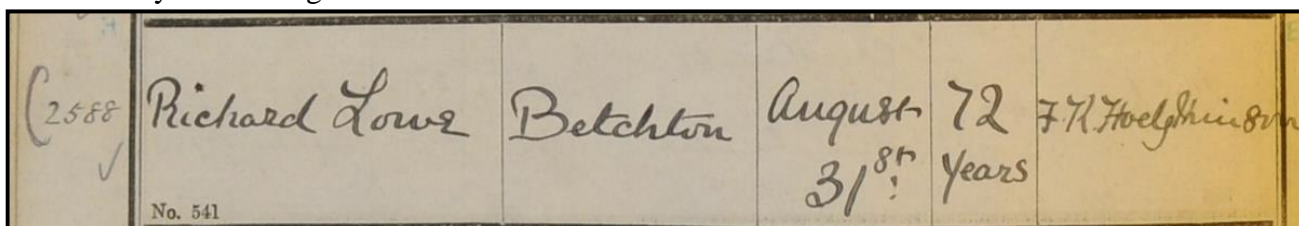

**LOWE** Richard Higham of Clewarth-hall Tyldesley Lancashire and of Gravel Bank-farm Betchton Sandbach Cheshire farmer died 28 August 1898 at Gravel Bank-farm Probate **Chester** 2 November to Elizabeth Higham Austin (wife of James Austin) Ellen Higham Cocker (wife of John Cocker) Mary Higham Stott (wife of Thomas Stott) and Richard Lowe Austin farmer Effects £5516 6s. 10d.

1898: Marriage of Richard Lowe Austin (25) and Harriet Green (25) at St. Stephen, Astley, on 9 May 1898. **Richard** was the son of **James Austin, Farmer**, and **Harriet** was the daughter of John Green, Farmer. Richard 's address was Cleworth Hall Farm, Tyldesley.
