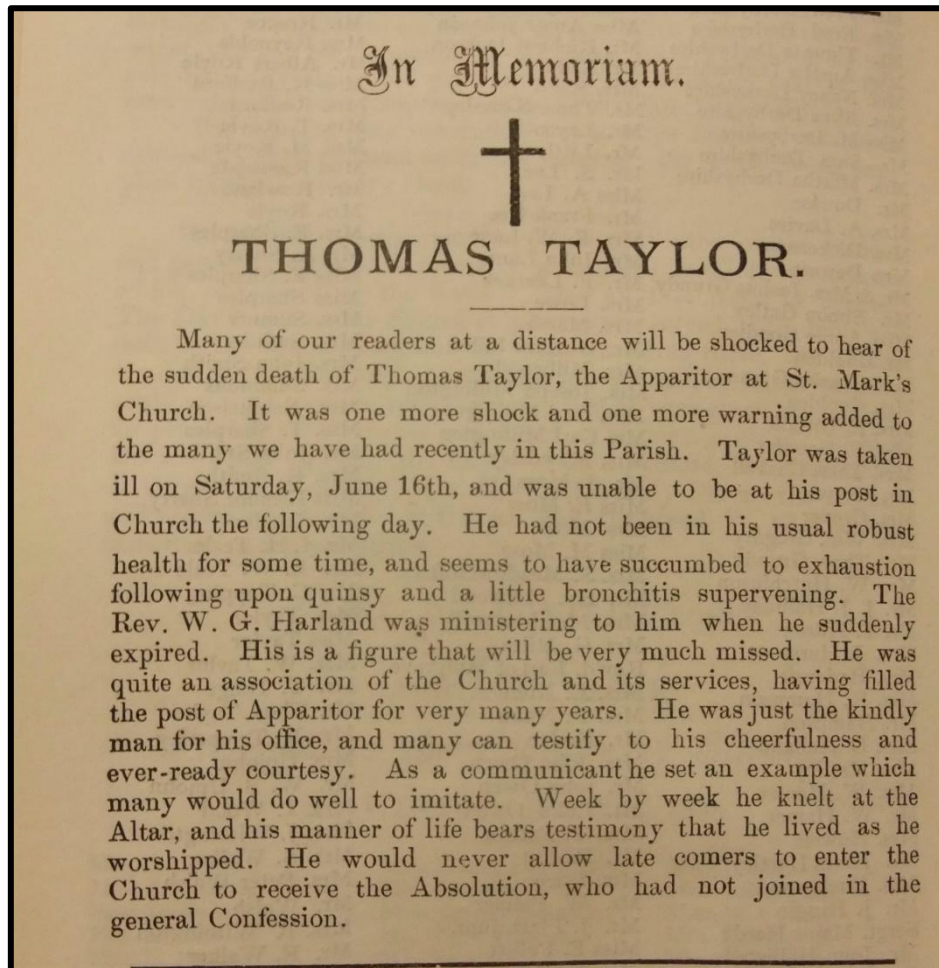

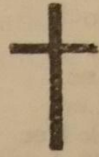

THOMAS TAYLOR.

Many of our readers at a distance will be shocked to hear of the sudden death of Thomas Taylor, the Apparitor at St. Mark's Church. It was one more shock and one more warning added to the many we have had recently in this Parish. Taylor was taken ill on Saturday, June 16th, and was unable to be at his post in Church the following day. He had not been in his usual robust health for some time, and seems to have succumbed to exhaustion following upon quinsy and a little bronchitis supervening. The Rev. W. G. Harland was ministering to him when he suddenly expired. His is a figure that will be very much missed. He was quite an association of the Church and its services, having filled the post of Apparitor for very many years. He was just the kindly man for his office, and many can testify to his cheerfulness and ever-ready courtesy. As a communicant he set an example which many would do well to imitate. Week by week he knelt at the Altar, and his manner of life bears testimony that he lived as he worshipped. He would never allow late comers to enter the Church to receive the Absolution, who had not joined in the general Confession.
