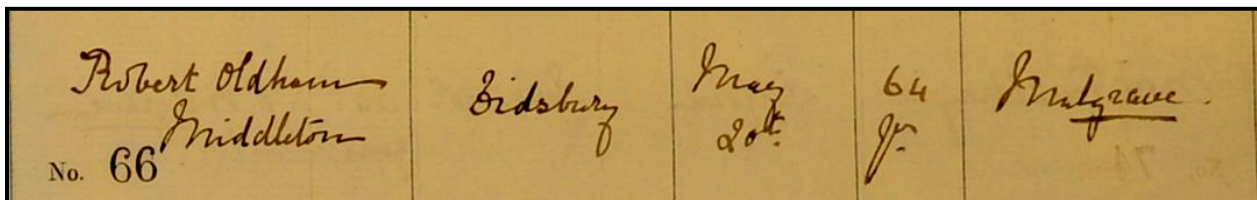

Death of the Rev. William Bently.— Our obituary to-day contains the announcement, which will be received with regret, of the death of the Rev. William Bently, son of the late Canon Bently, Rector of St. Matthew's, Campfield, this city. His decease was somewhat sudden, and was the result of attack of pleurisy and bronchitis, his illness, however, not taking serious turn till day or two ago. The rev. gentleman was late scholar of Lincoln College, Oxford, where he graduated with distinction. He took the degree of B.A. in 1878, and M.A. in 1882. In 1879 he was ordained deacon, and priest in 1880 by the Bishop of Salisbury. His first curacy was that of St. Edmund's, Salisbury, where he remained till 1883, when for about three months he served as curate at the parish church of Lytham. At the expiration of that period he accepted the curacy of St. James's, Birch-in-Rusholme, of which the Ven. Archdeacon Anson is rector. While there he was very successful in the conduct of men's class, held on Sunday afternoons, and gained the goodwill and affection of all with whom he came in contact. Shortly after the death of his father he resigned the appointment, and subsequently took a similar position in connection with the parish church at Swinton, under the Rev. H. R. Heywood. The deceased was only in his 30th year, and his removal terminates what promised to be a useful career.

[His mother was Elizabeth Middleton, sister of Thomas. She had married the Rev. Thomas Rothwell Bently]
