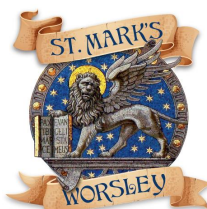

1833: Marriage of William Harrison, Farmer of Eccles, and Sarah Phillips of Chorlton, by Licence, on 14 June 1833, at St. John, Manchester.

1838: Birth on 14 December of **William Harrison**, son of William and Sarah (Philips), a Farmer, of Moss Side, Hulme. Baptised at St. George, Hulme, on 18 January 1839.
