Martha (HIGGINBOTTOM) JOHNSON

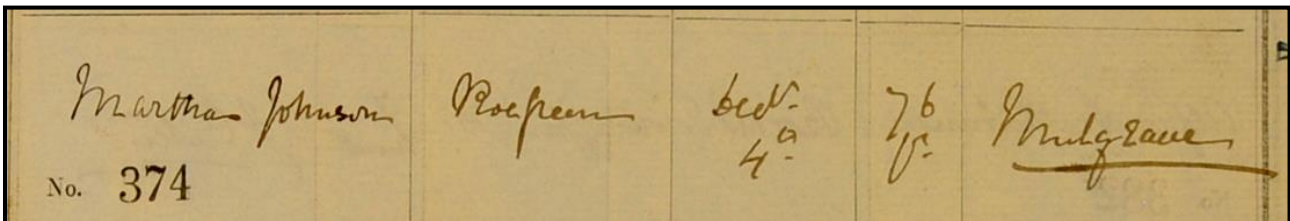

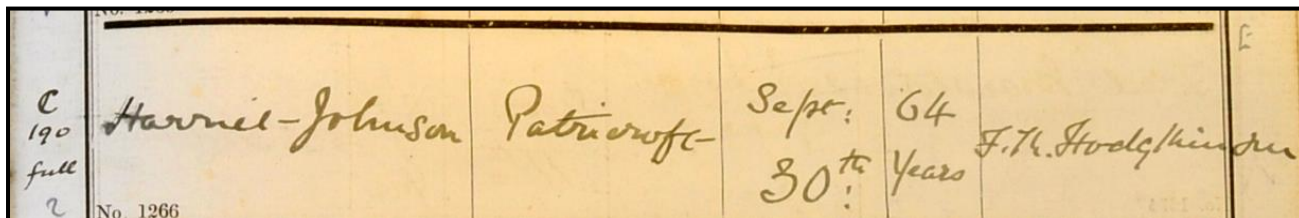
