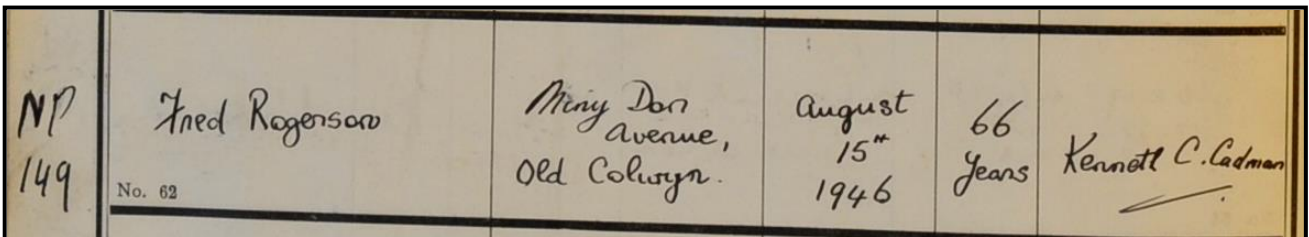
1932: Death of **Elizabeth Ann Rogerson** on **13 June 1932**. Buried at St. Mark's on 16 June 1932, aged 52 years.
