There are 105 names etched onto the plinth. Of these, 33 were servicemen who had no marked graves and whose names are recorded on memorials in Europe (*recorded as U*). 15 cannot be traced since their names are not easy to trace (*recorded as ?*). 49 are buried in marked graves overseas (*recorded as O*). 3 are buried in St. Mark's Churchyard (*recorded as SM*). The remaining 5 were buried in other locations around Manchester.
