

There are 2 possible baptisms recorded that could apply to **Thomas Salt.** Given his age at his death in 1884, (78), the record from 1806 is the more likely.

1806: Baptism of *Thomas, bastard son of Margaret Salt, of Worsley. Reputed father John Thornley, of Worsley, Collier.*

1809: Baptism of **Thomas Salt** at St. Mary, Eccles, on **17 September 1809.** The son of William Salt, Collier, and Jane. The register reads:

Thomas, son of William Salt of Worsley, Collier, by Jane his wife.

1830: Marriage of Thomas Salt and Alice Tildesley at St. Mary, Eccles, on 21 September 1830.

1883: Death of **Alice Salt**, aged 73 years, on 24 January **1883**. She was buried at St. Mark's on 27 January 1883.
