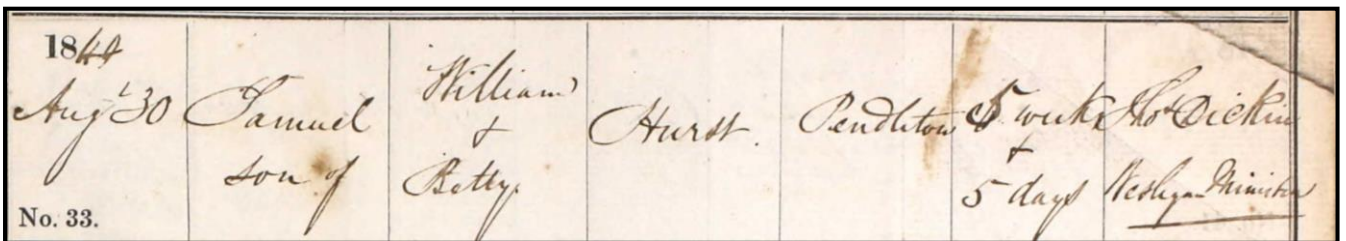

A second instance of the families of Hurst and Stones being joined together.
