1816: Baptism of **William Berry** on 4 February 1816 at St. Mary, Eccles, the son of Thomas and Mary Berry, Collier, of Worsley.

c1814: Birth of **Ellen Potter** in Worsley. [She may have been Ellen Potter, daughter of William Potter and Mary, baptised at St. Mary, Eccles, on 25 September 1814].

1837: Marriage of **William Berry** and **Mary (Ellen) Potter** at St. Mary, Eccles, on 23 January 1837.

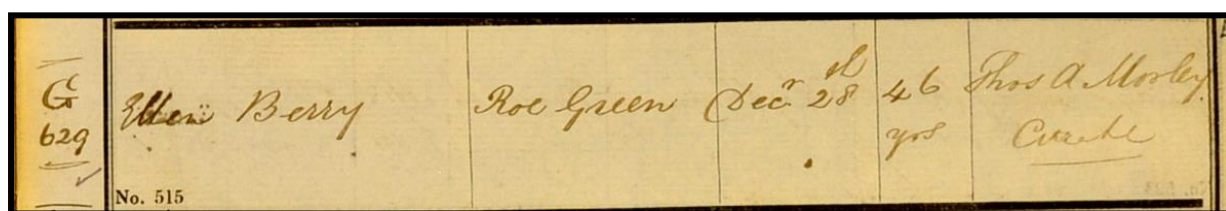

1858: Death of **Ellen Berry**, aged 44 years, on 25 December **1858**. Buried at St. Mark's on 28 December 1858. [Note the discrepancy between the stone and the register].



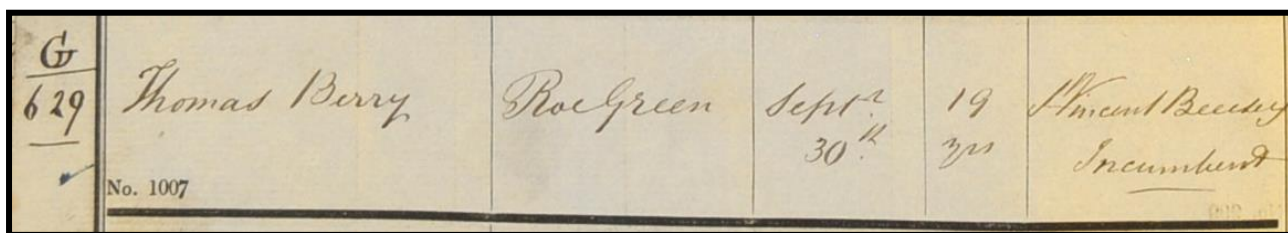
1860: Death of **Edward Davies**, aged 4 days, grandson of William Berry, and son of Hannah Berry and William Henry Davies. Buried on 2 July 1860. He was buried in the family grave G629.
