



The Manchester Courier on Wednesday 2 December 1885 carried this announcement:

OUR WAREHOUSE, 12, York-street, and Offices at London and Glasgow, WILL BE CLOSED TOMORROW, December 3rd, owing to the Funeral of the late Mr. William Scott. JONES BROTHERS & CO.



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In the **1851** census, Emma was living with her family at Haslam Hey, her father being a Bleacher and Dyer employing 250 people, and also being a farmer of 200 acres. Emma was then 27 and described as a Lady.
