*SCOTT - On the 29th ult., at the Woodlands, Higher Broughton, **William Scott**, aged 71.*

The Manchester Courier on Wednesday 2 December **1885** carried this announcement:

*OUR WAREHOUSE, 12, York-street, and Offices at London and Glasgow, WILL BE CLOSED TOMORROW, December 3rd, owing to the Funeral of the late **Mr. William Scott**. JONES BROTHERS & CO.*
