Phyllis (Reynolds) Ross was baptised on 15 June 1890 at St. John, Lytham. She died on 14 August 1963 at Vancouver, British Columbia. She clearly had travelled a lot. On 26 March 1920 she arrived at Liverpool on board the *Digby*, from St. John's, Newfoundland, with a young daughter Elizabeth. On 6 December 1922, she arrived again at Liverpool on board the *Digby*, Furness Line, from St. John's, Newfoundland, with her mother (aged 63) and 3 children - Elizabeth, Wallace and Eric. Later, on 21 April 1928, she arrived at Liverpool on the *Nova Scotia*, Furness Line, aged 40 and a Housewife. Her address in the U.K. was "The Bield", Prestwood, Great Missenden, Bucks. Her husband had died in 1938 in St. John's. He too had crossed the Atlantic many times but at different times from his wife. He was an Engineer. In the 1939 Register, she was living as a Widow in Amersham, recorded as Unpaid Domestic Duties, with a son, John, aged 18, an apprentice at Boots Chemist. Also at that address was her mother, **Elizabeth Ann**, working for Unpaid Domestic Duties.

Elizabeth Ann left a will. She died on 1 April **1942** and was of The Hollies, Grimsdells Lane, Amersham, Bucks. She was by now a widow but had died at Garden Cottage, Langley Road, Iver. Her effects were left to Phyllis Blakemore Ross, widow, and Ernest Acaster, Bank Manager.

Herbert James Blakemore Reynolds, who was born on 11 August **1894**, was baptised at St. Peter, Swinton, on 10 October. At the age of 16, in **1901**, he was a pupil at Sedbergh. He departed from Plymouth on 3 May **1912** on the *Corinthian*, Allan Line, bound for Montreal. He was then 19 and listed as a Stableman. He served as Captain, then Major, in the E. Lancs. Div. R.A.S.C. in World War 1. The first Theatre of War where he served was Gallipoli, where he arrived in September **1914**. He was later awarded an O.B.E. On 29 Aug **1958**, Herbert and his wife, Dora, arrived at the port of London on *M.V. Warwick Castle*, Union Castle Line, from Beira, Kenya. His occupation was given as Engineer. Their last country of residence was South Africa. At the time of his death on 23 March **1969**, he had been living at 1 Oakfields, Sevenoaks, Kent.
