**Alice Ann Grundy** was baptised at St. Mary, Ellenbrook, on 12 February **1843**, the daughter of James and Ruth of Tyldesley. James was an engineer. Given the frequency of this name, it has not proved easy to correctly identify him

He was possibly James Grundy, baptised 2 February 1815 at Eccles, a son of Peter Grundy and Alice, Farmer, of Hulton.







In the **1939** Register, **Ruth Katie** was living alone at 4 Worsley Road, a School Mistress, born on 3 December 1879.

**Ruth Katie Grundy** left a will. Her address at her death was **Belconie Cottage**, Worsley. Probate was granted on 4 May 1949 to Katharine Mary Malins Smith, Spinster, and Sarah Dorothea Bury, a widow. Her effects were in excess of £2.600.
