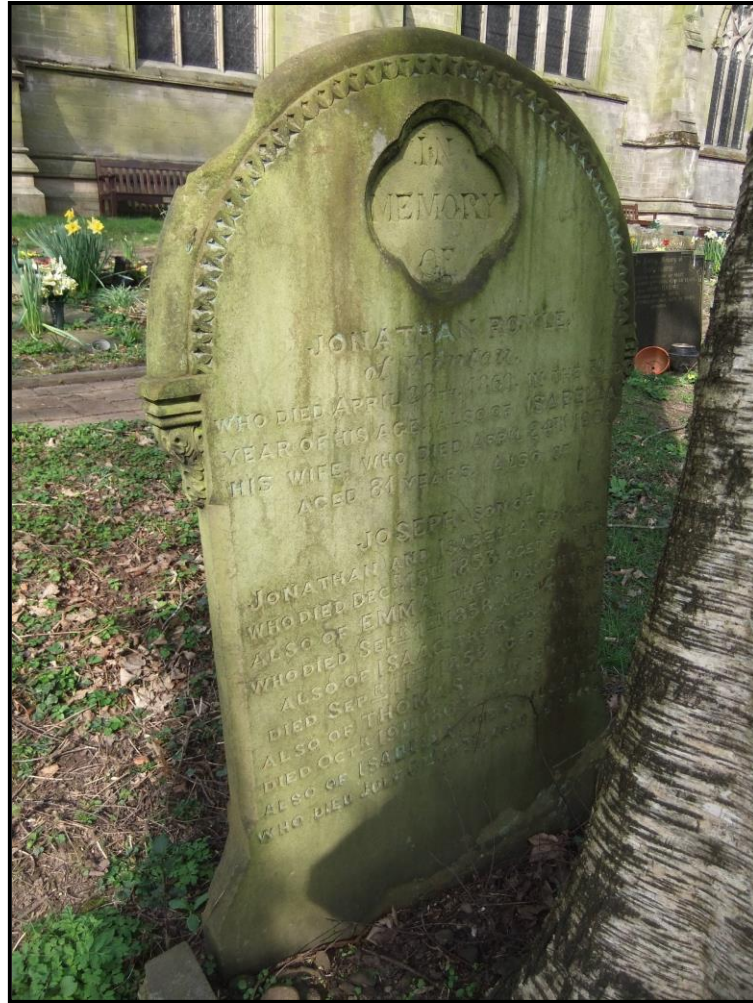

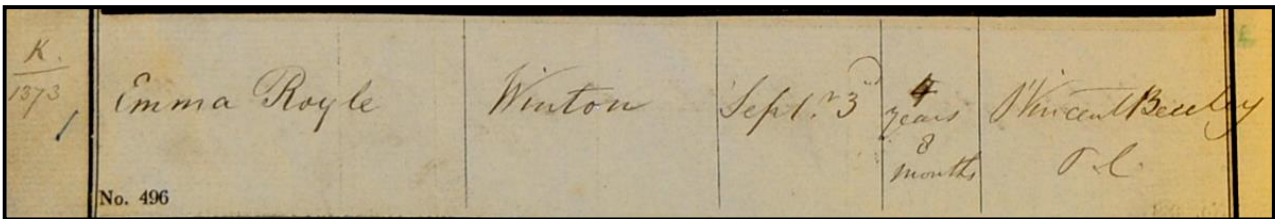

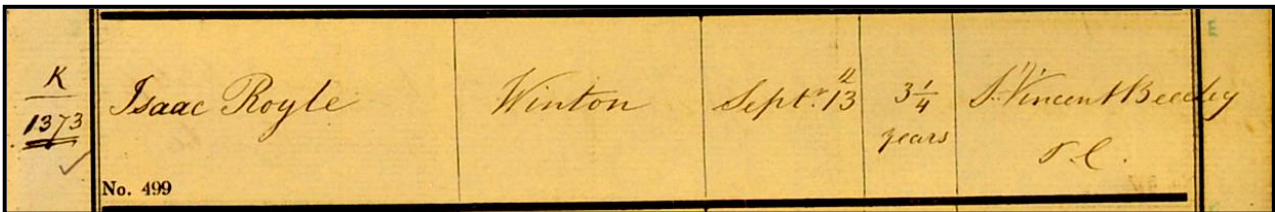

This census would seem to show that Jonathan and Isabella had 10 children – 3 sons and 7 daughters. In fact, they had 2 other children between 1851 and 1861 (1 son and 1 daughter shown above, both of whom died in infancy), making a total thus far of 12 children. Then, add also, Joseph (1848), Joseph Henry (1862) and Albert Edward (1865) - making a grand total of 15!!

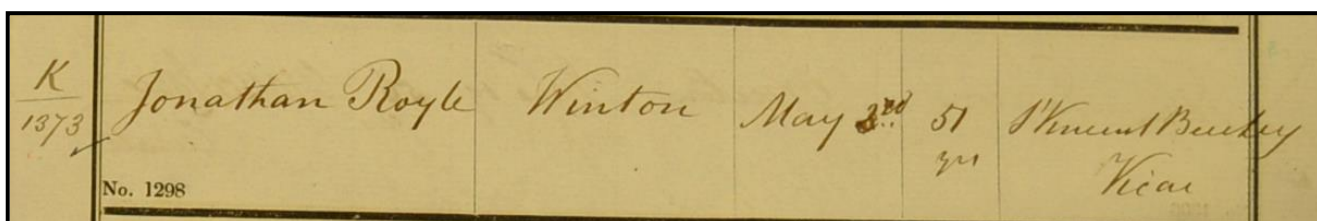

1862: At the funeral of the second Earl of Ellesmere on Saturday 4 October, **Jonathan** was one of numerous tenants who joined the procession from the hall to the church.

1866: In May, **Jonathan Royle** was one of several members of a committee, almost 80 in number, formed to provide a form of lasting tribute to the late Dowager Countess of Ellesmere. The committee's chairman was Fereday Smith and its vice-chairman was the Rev. St. Vincent Beechey.

1867: At the third exhibition of the WORSLEY AND SWINTON DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL AND HORTICULTURAL SHOW, amongst the prize winners were: *Cheese.—Best sample (not less than three) of his or her own make. £1, Jonathan Royle, Winton. Best sample, to dealers (not less than three). £1 George Tyldesley, Roe Green ; second, 10s.. William Parr, Patricroft. Butter and Eggs.—Best sample of butter, not less than 3lb. weight, £2, Jonathan Royle, Winton; second, £1 10s, William Green Little Hulton. Best dish of twelve eggs, the produce of his or her own poultry, 10s., Jonathan Royle, Winton; second, 7s. 6d., Henry Neild, Worsley.*

1869: Burial at St. Mark, Worsley, on 3 May 1869, of **Jonathan Royle**, aged 51.

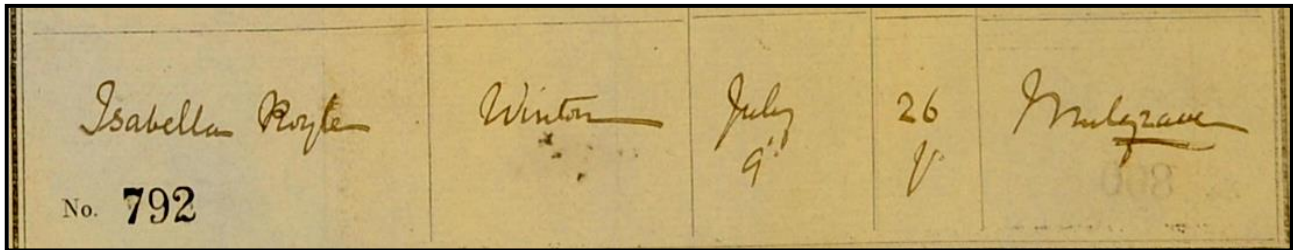
