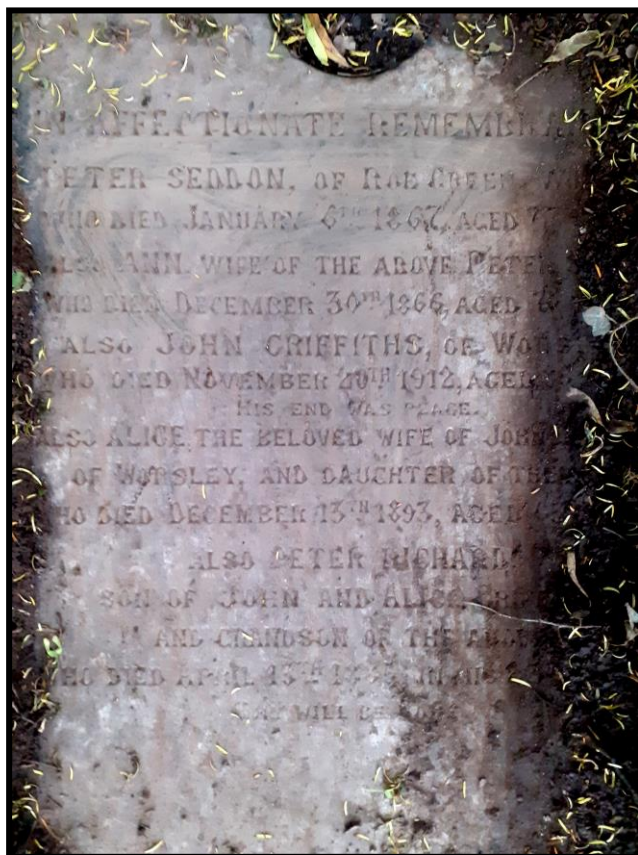

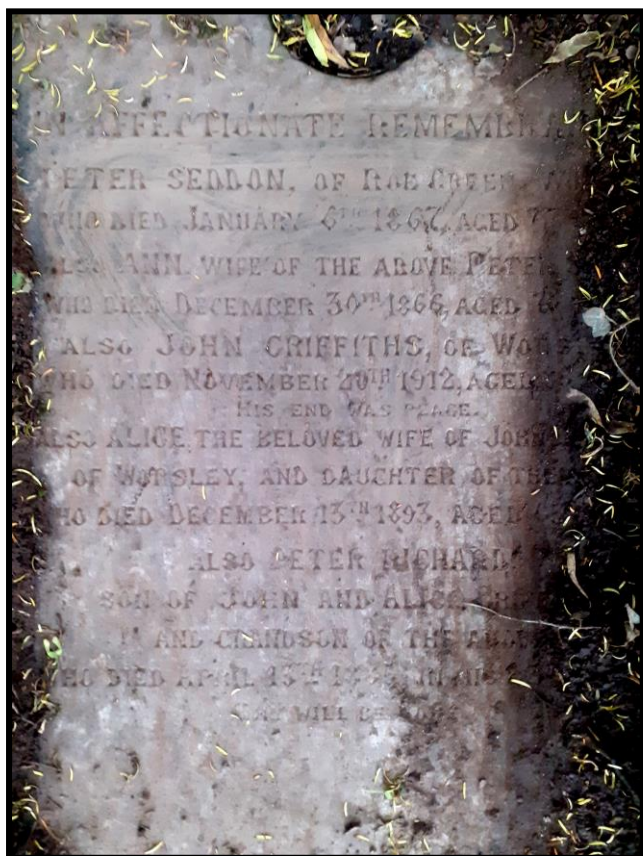

1788: Baptism of **Peter Seddon** on 16 October **1788** at St. Mary, Ellenbrook. The son of Josiah and Alice (née Unsworth) Seddon, a Weaver.

1824: Marriage of **Peter Seddon** and **Ann Collier** at St. Mary, Eccles,
Marriage: 8 July **1824** St Mary the Virgin, Eccles.

Peter Seddon - this Parish

Hannah Collier - this Parish

Witnesses: Thomas Turner; John Hurst (X); Anne Owen (X)

Married by Licence by William Keeling Curate

1824: Baptism of their son Richard at St. Mary, Eccles, on 21 November **1824**, the son of Peter and Hannah of Worsley, Labourer.

1827: Baptism of their son Samuel at St. Mary, Eccles, on 1 July **1827**, the son of Peter and Hannah of Worsley, Weaver.

1831: Baptism of their daughter Alice at St. Mary, Eccles, on 20 March **1831**, the son of Peter and Anne of Worsley, Labourer.

1832: Baptism of Peter on 29 April **1832** at St. Mary, Eccles. [He was buried on 25 July 1833 at Eccles].

1841 census: Roe Green, Worsley.

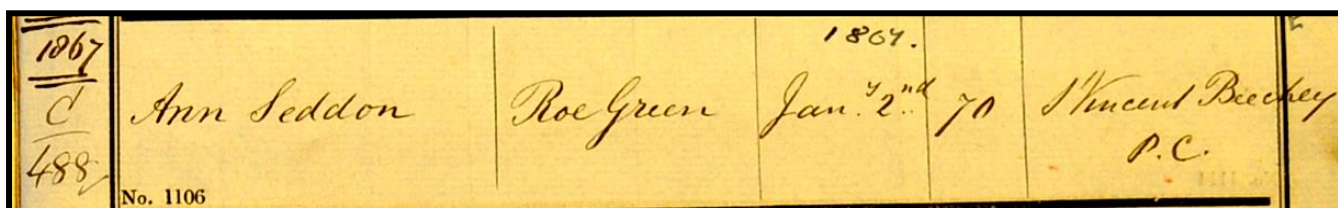

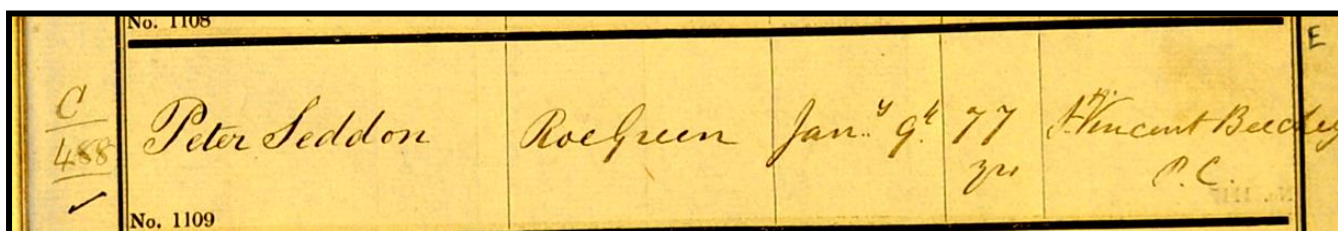
