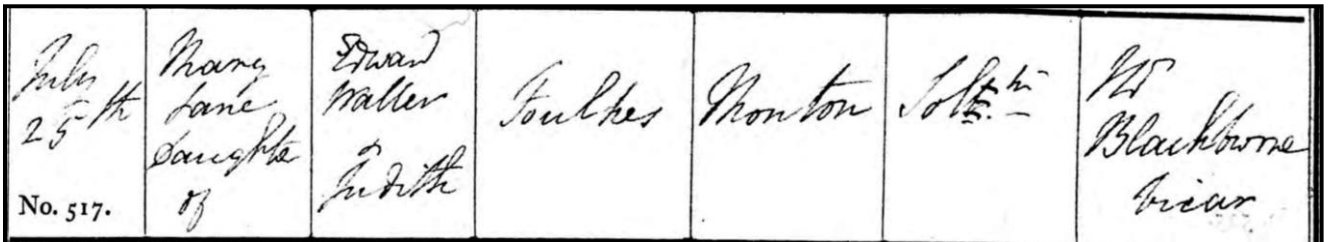

Mary Jane Foulkes was baptised at St. Mary, Eccles, on 25 July **1826**. The family was from Monton.



Edward Waller Foulkes, (q.v.), her father, was the son of Edward and Mary Foulkes. He was born on 6 September **1796** and baptised on 10 December at St. George, Manchester. His father was also an Attorney. Edward married Judith Heaward at St. Mary, Stockport, on 7 February **1824**.

Mary Jane Foulkes married Joseph Hodgson, Auctioneer, on 28 April 1846 at St. Mary, Eccles. Joseph was living at that time at Argyle Street, Hamilton Square, Birkenhead.

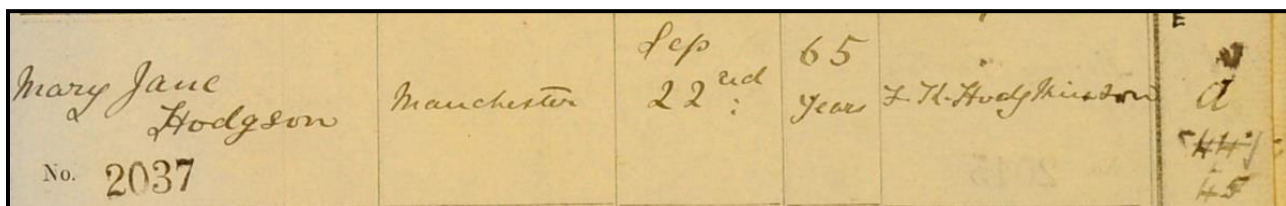

Mary Jane Hodgson died on 17 September 1890 at 6 Crystal Terrace, South Shore, Blackpool. Her residence in Manchester had been 199 Great Cheetham Street, Higher Broughton. She was buried in the churchyard on 22 September.

The *Preston Herald* on Saturday 20 September 1890 reported her death quite succinctly:

Hodgson - September 17, at Blackpool, Mary Jane Hodgson, of Higher Broughton, aged 66 years.

As for Joseph Hodgson, he was baptised on 22 September **1815** at St. Mary, Cheltenham, the son of Joseph Hodgson and Catherine. He was an Auctioneer.

The *Liverpool Mercury* of Tuesday 10 December **1861** reported the death of Joseph Hodgson:

Hodgson - Dec. 6th, at his residence, Birkenhead Park, Mr. Joseph Hodgson.

The Will of Joseph Hodgson late of Birkenhead in the County of **Chester** Auctioneer deceased who died 6 December 1861 at Birkenhead aforesaid was proved at **Chester** by the oath of Mary Jane Hodgson of Hope-terrace Lower-Broughton in the Borough of Salford in the County of Lancaster Widow the Relict the sole Executrix.

Regrettably, no burial record for him has yet been found.
