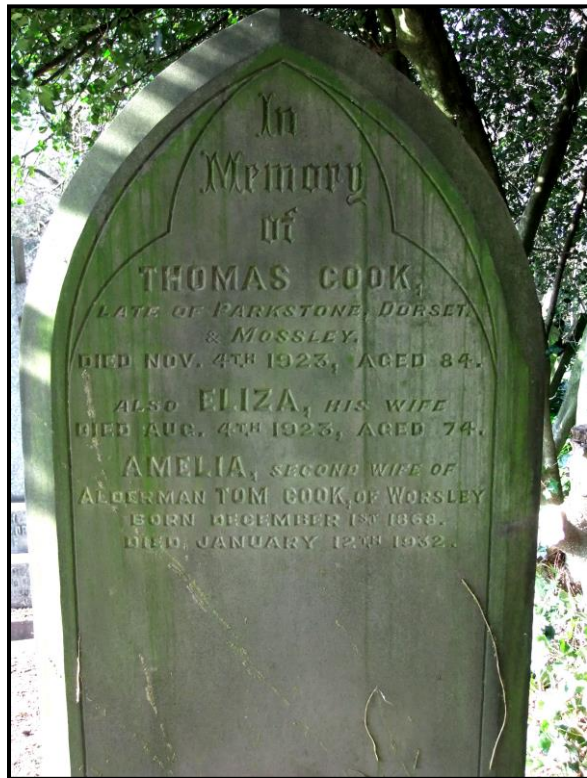

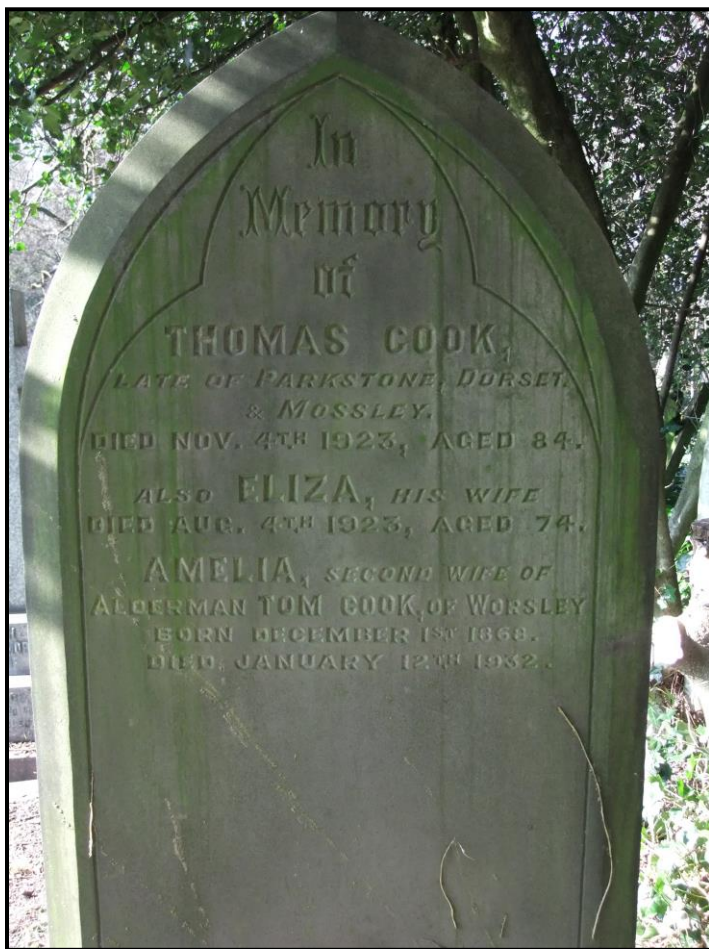

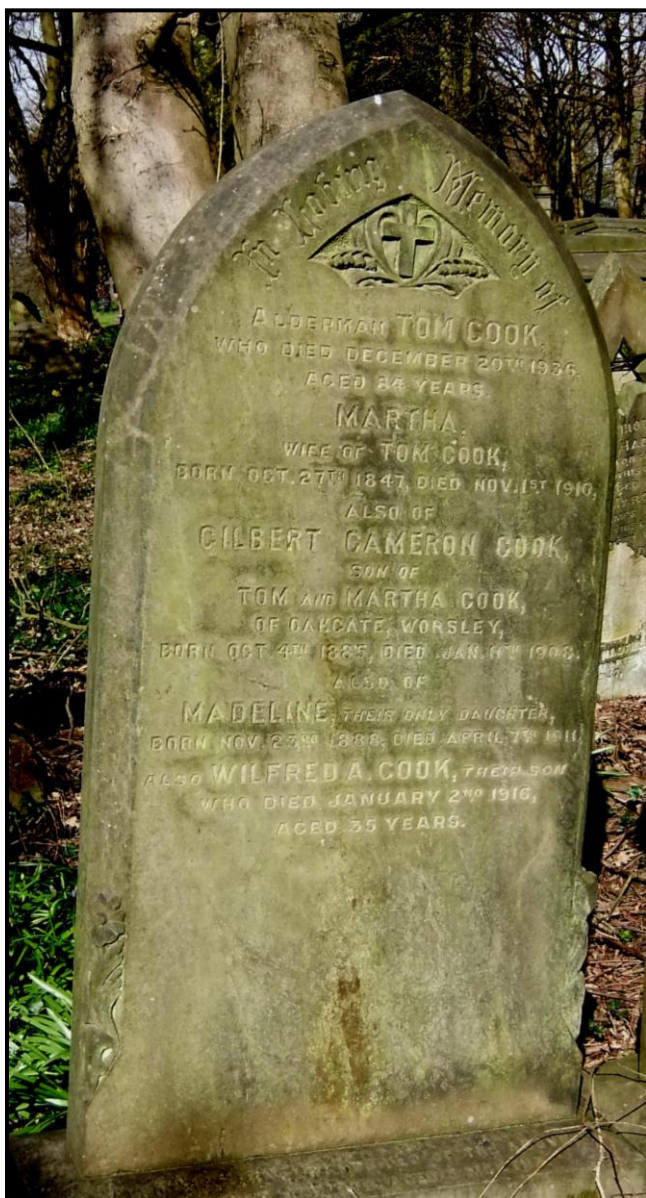

According to the *Freemason Registers*, **Tom Cook**, in late **1900**, was residing at 35 Mossley Road, Cheetham. He was 47 (hence, born 1853), and an architect.

In a separate part of the churchyard, is buried **TOM COOK**, whose name is alluded to on the grave of his father, **Thomas Cook**.

**Alderman Tom Cook** died on 20 December **1936**, aged 84 years. In the same plot (H1042) were buried ...

Both Gilbert and Madeline were registered as living at Oakgate. When Wilfred (Aynsley) died, he was registered as being at the Workhouse Infirmary, Patricroft.

**Tom Cook** married **Martha Mitchell** in the first quarter of **1875** at Ashton-under-Lyne, at an, as yet, unidentified location.

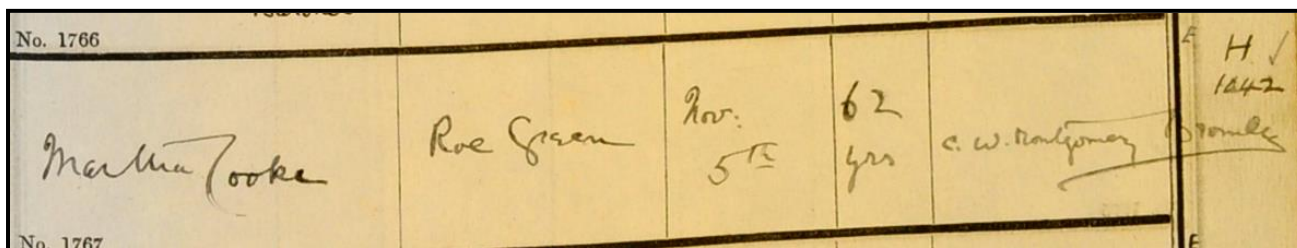

This census shows that **Tom** and **Martha** had 6 children, of whom 1 had died at the time it was taken on the night of 2 April 1911. Only 5 days later Madeline died, aged 22.
