**1883:** Richard Carter Stanning married Emma Dutton at All Souls, Bolton, on 11 September 1883. (Richard Carter Stanning, of The Elms, 27 Talbot Road, Southport, died on 25 May 1925 and is buried at St. Peter's, Halliwell. Emma Dutton Stanning is also buried at Halliwell, having died in 1928. In January 1894, she had been admitted to a Lunatic Asylum in Haydock).

**1886:** Baptism of **Richard Henry Stanning** at All Souls, Bolton, on 21 March 1886, the son of Richard Carter Stanning and Emma.

He was initiated on 14 October **1920** at Milton Lodge, Ashton under Lyne. His address was recorded as Stockport and he was an Iron and Steel Merchant.

**1920:** 12 July.

He applied for his 3 war medals – Victory, British and Star. The theatre of war in which he served was France. His date of entry therein was 25 September 1915.

**1923:** Birth of a son, Myles Reid Stanning, on 29 July **1923**, at St. Mark's. In the **1939** Register, he was at Oakham School, Rutland, aged 16.
