**1829:** 25 May. **Henry Norris** of Cheadle in the county and Diocese of Chester, Surgeon, made an oath and declared an intention to marry **Ellen Rogers** of Heaton Norris in the county of Lancaster, both being of 21 years and upward, in the parish church of Cheadle.

**1831:** Birth of George Taylor Norris on 11 July 1831, son of Henry and Ellen Norris, of Cheadle. Baptised at St. Thomas, Heaton Norris, on 11 September 1831.

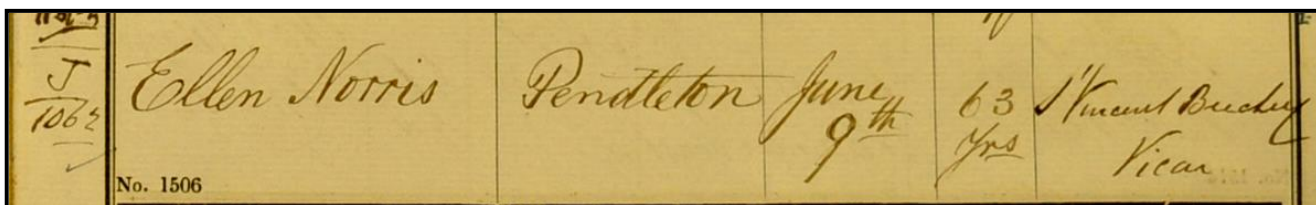

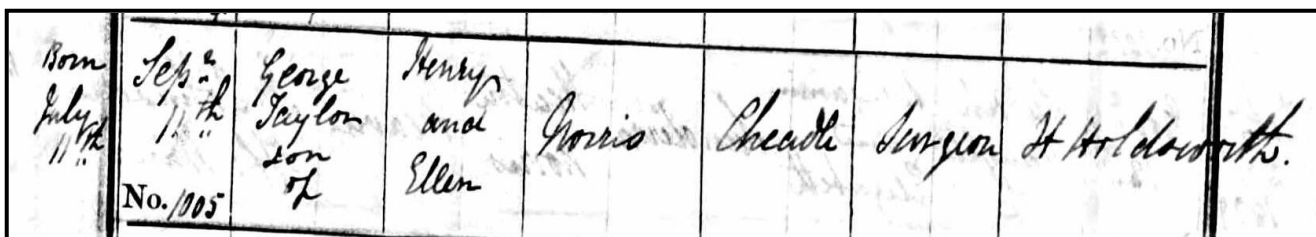

DEATH: NORRIS. March 28<sup>th</sup>, near St. Antonio, Texas, after a few days' illness, George T. Norris, Esq., late of Stockport and Manchester, aged 42 years.
