

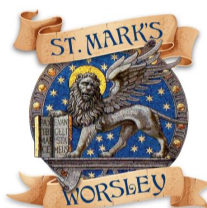

**JOB YATES**  
 Of Roe Green  
 Who died 31<sup>st</sup> August **1909**  
 Aged 73 years  
*“Well done thou good and faithful servant  
 Enter thou into the joy of the Lord”*  
 Also **LAVINA**, wife of above  
 Who died 26<sup>th</sup> February **1916**  
 Aged 76 years  
 Also **ARTHUR**, son of Job & Lavina Yates  
 Who died 7<sup>th</sup> April **1869**  
 Aged 3 months  
 Also **EDMUND**, son of the above  
 Who died 7<sup>th</sup> June **1873**, aged 6 months  
 Also **ELLEN**, daughter of the above  
 Who died November **1881**, aged 18 months

**c.1836:** Birth of **Job Yates**. [This is based simply upon his stated age at the censuses. It is surprising that no record has been found of his birth or baptism, nor of his marriage in the first half of 1860].

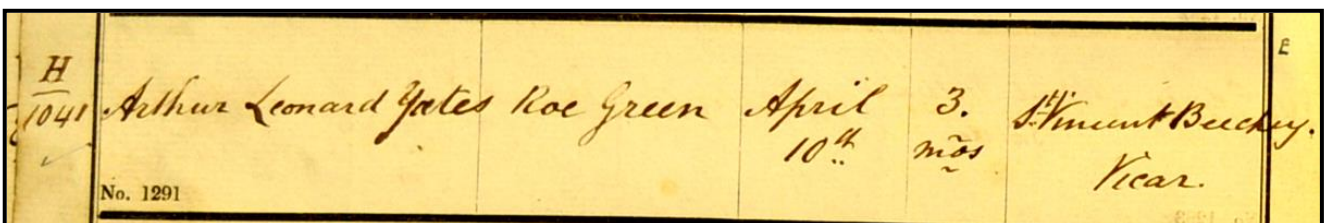
**Lavina Pollitt**, aged 11, daughter of Abraham and Martha Pollitt. Her father was a Shop keeper.

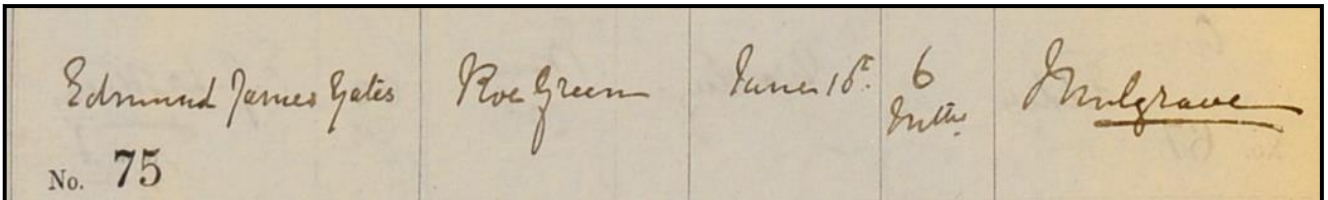

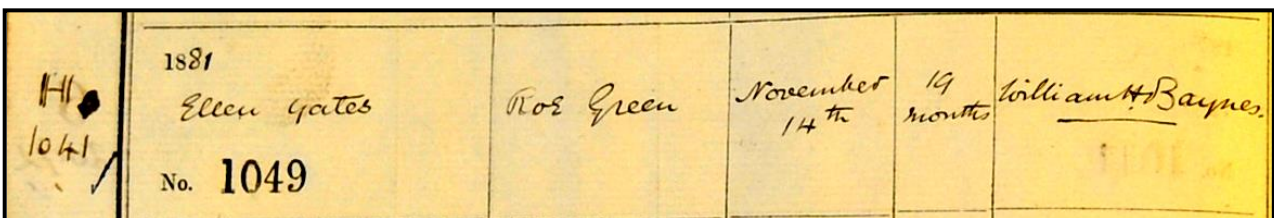
