**TUNNER** James of 52 Coupe-brow Boothstown Worsley Lancashire died 12 October 1912 near the White Horse Inn Worsley-road Swinton Lancashire Probate **Manchester** 26 October to William Tunner joiner and Matthew Kniveton banksman at a colliery. Effects £237 7s. 2d.
