Thomas was baptised at St. Mark's on 14 March **1852** by the Rev. St. Vincent Beechey. His parents were **William Wilson** (q.v. in a separate file) and his wife Anne.

From the **1861** census, we know that he was a Scholar, living with the family at the Old Warke, Worsley. By **1871**, he was still there at home, this time as a Warehouseman. The census of 1881 was taken on 3 April **1881**, just 25 days before his marriage. His address was still at the Old Warke, but he was now 29 and a Cigar Merchant.



Three of their children appeared in each of the three census referred to above - Ella Marian, Edith and Mabel Ramsden. They did have a fourth daughter, Alice Maud, but she sadly died in infancy on 30 June **1885**, aged 1 year and 3 days. She was buried in the same plot, with her parents, (a49a). Her mother, Julia, died much later on 6 January **1940**, aged 82. Alice Maud had been baptised at the Cathedral on 17 July **1884** (born 27 June 1884). Edith was baptised at St. Clement, Greenheys, on 19 July 1883 and Ella Marian at the same church on 5 April 1882.



WILSON Thomas of Fernacre Brooklands - road Brooklands Cheshire and of 27 Fountain - street Manchester cigar merchant died 7 May 1919 at Fernacre Probate Chester 12 August to Julia Wilson widow. Effects £21345 6s. 2d.

Six years after his death, (**1925**), the firm of Thomas Wilson (Cigar Merchant) Ltd, was wound up in chambers in Warrington. It would also appear that his widow, Julia, was not buried at St. Mark's, since her name does not appear in the burial records.
