1828: Marriage of John *Bardsley* and Charlotte Burgess at St. Mary, Manchester, on 21 February 1828.

1829: Baptism of **Elizabeth Hannah (Hebdon) Bardsley** at Manchester Cathedral on 23 August 1829, the daughter of John and Charlotte Bardsley. The family was of Ardwick and John was a Dyer.

1850: Marriage of John Hebdon and **Elizabeth Hannah Bardsley** by Licence at Manchester Cathedral on 21 February 1850. She was the daughter of John Bardsley, a Sizer.



NOTES.

This memorial presents a mystery. No record has yet been found of the death of her husband John Hebden, sometime between 1861 and 1871. Furthermore, why is she buried in a plot with people who do not seem to have any connection to her/ Certainly, she did have 5 sisters, hence the reference on the stone to '*Our Dear Sister.*' And her body was brought to this churchyard for burial. The other people buried all died many years before Elizabeth.
