

In loving memory of Samuel FILDES of Winton who died November 1st 1897 aged 72 yrs. 'Thy will be done'. Also of **SARAH** wife of the above who died March 8th 1903 aged 77 yrs. 'At rest'. **JOHN** the beloved husband of SARAH YORK died April 13th **1934** in his 81st yr. Also **SARAH** wife of the above died May 14th**1945** aged 81 yrs 'May she rest in peace'. (a289)

There was a marriage on 18 May 1815 at St. Mary the Virgin, Eccles, between:

Thomas Fildes - (X), 21, this Parish

Anne Holt - (X), 25, this Parish Witness: W. B. Guest; Isaac Holt, (X)

Thomas was a Blacksmith. Anne and he were to have a total of 9 children, all baptised at Eccles:

Samuel baptised 14 January 1816 (Buried 18 March 1820, aged 4)

Elizabeth bapt. 24 August 1817

Isaac (Fields-sic) bapt. 12 September 1819

Esther bapt. 8 October 1820

Anne bapt. 23 February 1823


Samuel bapt. 3 April 1825

Thomas bapt. 2 September 1827 (Buried 15 August 1833, aged 6)

William bapt. 17 January 1830

Jesse bapt. 13 May 1832

In each entry, **Thomas** was a Blacksmith and their abode was simply written as Worsley.



The first national census was for **1841** and the information provided was minimal; name, age (rounded down to the nearest 5, except for young children), occupation:

The five censuses printed above portray a simple life, devoted to his wife with no children of their own, living within the same community, engaged in an essential occupation at that time.

Samuel FILDES died 1 November **1897** aged 72. Despite his hardworking job, he did leave a small will.

FILDES Samuel of Buryfield, Winton, Barton-upon-Irwell, Lancashire. Blacksmith. Died 1 November 1897. Probate Manchester 24 November to Sarah Fildes, widow. Effects £408 5s. 7d.

1903: Sarah FILDES, wife of Samuel, died in 8 March 1903. aged 77.

FILDES Sarah of 1 King William Street, Winton, Barton-upon-Irwell, widow, died 8 March 1903. Probate Manchester 3 April to Emily Pollitt spinster and Henry Wood butcher. Effects £548 2s. 3d.
