Robert Lansdale Temperley and his wife, **Sarah**, were buried within 4 days of each other in **1902** in plot G878. On 29 December **1902**, the same year, their son Robert Charles was buried in the same grave.

To Thomas Temperley and Elizabeth (Hallows).

His father was a Joiner, but curiously his abode was recorded as Worsley. Thomas was born in Worsley on 4 October 1800 and Elizabeth in Stockton Quay, about 1807.

It seems likely that Thomas Sharples married Ann Berry at Manchester Cathedral by Licence on 21 August **1849**. At that ceremony, Thomas was aged 47, a Bachelor and Labourer, of the Crescent, Salford, the son of Abel Sharples, a Labourer. Ann was aged 50, a Spinster, of Eccles, the daughter of Robert Berry, a Farmer. The ages are roughly consistent with the ages in the census. In all cases, Ann was recorded as being older than Thomas. It will also explain the change of surname for Ann between 1841 and 1851.
