[Trying to trace the life story of **John Claridge** has proven to be a very difficult task. Although it is not a very common name, it has been enormously difficult to pinpoint him. He seems to have travelled widely across the country, being born and later dying in Oxford. Furthermore, there is only one verifiable record of a child being born. On top of that, there is evidence of 2 other John Claridges who were married to a Maria. What follows is a best guess, given the paucity of reliable evidence.]

From the Oxford Journal on Saturday 24 May 1879:

DEATH - May 15, at Summertown, Mr. John Claridge, aged 59.

CLARIDGE John.

Personal Estate under £1,500. Resworn May 1880 under £800. 12 June. The Will of John Claridge late of Summertown near Oxford in the County of Oxford Gentleman who died 15 May 1879 at Summertown was proved at Oxford by Ann Claridge of Summertown Widow the Relict and James Slatter Steane of the City of Oxford Wine Merchant the Executors.

From the Oxford Times on Saturday 31 May 1879:

JOHN CLARIDGE, Deceased. All persons having any claims upon or being indebted to the estate of JOHN CLARIDGE, late of Summertown. near the city of Oxford, Contractor, deceased, are requested forthwith to forward and pay the same respectively to us on behalf of Mrs. Ann Claridge and Mr. James Slatter Steane, the Executrix and Executor of the will of the said John Claridge, deceased.
