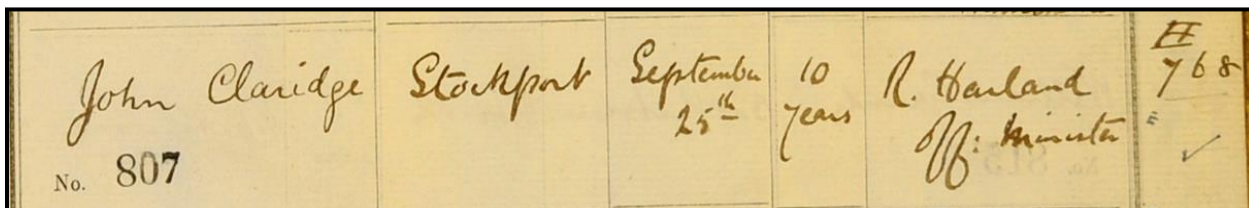

In his occupation as a Surveyor, the name of **Thomas Claridge** would have appeared in numerous public announcements in newspapers and street notices. In April **1874**, he was working for the Swinton and Pendlebury Board. One such notice was for contractors to tender for the building of a

sewer system and junction around Park Street. "Plans, sections, specifications, and stipulations, can be seen and form of tender obtained on application to Mr. **Thomas Claridge**, Surveyor to the Board, at the offices, Manchester Road, Swinton."

By August **1874**, he resigned from the position of Surveyor and Collector at Swinton, a post which was then advertised at a salary of £120 per annum, with house, coals and gas. He had transferred to the Stockport and Hyde Highway Board by October **1874**. In March **1883**, a notice appeared outlining plans of six cottages, with stable and coach-house to be built at London Road, Hazel Grove, for Mr. **Thomas Claridge**. He remained at the Stockport Board until his untimely death in **1898**.

1879: Death of their son John on 20 September **1879**. Aged 10 years, he was buried at St. Mark's on 25 September **1879**.

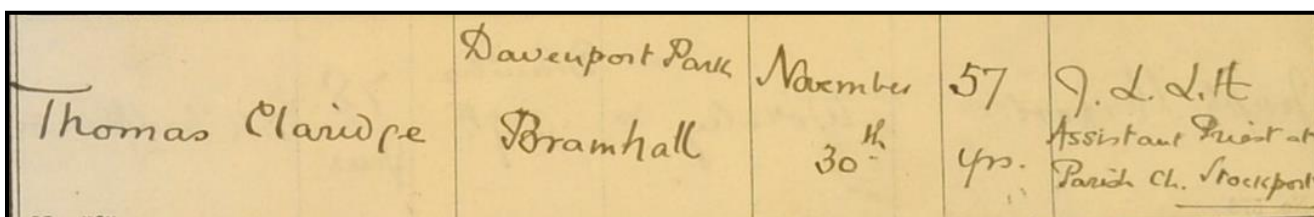
1898: *Manchester Times*: Friday 2 December **1898**.

The death has occurred somewhat' suddenly of Mr. Thomas Claridge, for eight years surveyor to the Swinton Local Board, for 20 years surveyor to the Stockport and District Highway Board, and upto his decease surveyor to the Disley Distict Council. He was formerly engaged upon engineering works in Brussels and other continental cities. He was 58 years of age, and was well known throughout Cheshire and Lancashire.

1898: *Alderley & Wilmslow Advertiser*: Friday 2 December **1898**.

CLARIDGE. On the 27th November, at his residence, Devonshire House, Davenport Park, Stockport, Thomas Claridge, in his 58th year. Interred at St. Mark's Church, Worsley, on Wednesday, the 30th. Friends will kindly accept this (the only) intimation.

His body was interred at St. Mark's on 30 November **1898**.
