Thomas Bracewell Midgley was the son of William Midgley and Martha Bracewell.
William was born on 11 July 1816 and baptised at Hope Chapel (Particular Baptist), Hope Street, Rochdale - the son of John and Ann Midgley (née Whildman), Weaver.

On 22 October **1845**, **William** married Jane Bird at St. Mary's, Manchester. His occupation was recorded as Townsman. This was confirmed in the census of **1851**. Her maiden name recurs.

It is of interest to note that, by this time, **William's** first wife Jane had been dead for 3 years. And that the young housekeeper was Martha Bracewell - this surname being the second name of **Thomas Bracewell Midgley.** And then we find, very shortly after the census, a record of a marriage between **William Midgley** and Martha Bracewell.

Thomas was born Manchester in the second quarter of **1861**, according to the National Index of Births. However, he was baptised much later on 8 March **1877** at Holy Rood, Swinton, and his parents were recorded as William and Martha Mary of Swinton. William was a Merchant. The birth year of **1861** was added in a margin.
