1837: Baptism of **Enoch Hulse**, son of Thomas and Esther Hulse, at Runcorn on 17 December 1837. This record appeared in "England, Cheshire Non-conformist Records, 1671-1900".

1861: Enoch and Dorothy (Pritchard) were married at St. Mary's, Eccles, on 11th April 1861. Enoch was then a Timekeeper and his father, Thomas, was a Boat Builder. Both signed their names clearly.

GEOFFREY HULSE grandson died October 2nd 1904 aged 14 days.

This young boy was named **Geoffrey Howell Hulse**, grandson of Enoch and Dorothy Hulse, died on 2 October 1904, and was buried in his grandfather's grave on 6 October. He was only 14 days old. He was, in fact, the son of Thomas Pritchard and Elizabeth Hulse (q.v.).
