The curious thing about this gentleman is that tracking him has proved to be very difficult. No trace has been found of him in any available census. Hence, no trace can be made of his father's name. Furthermore, in the 1891 census, which should show him, his wife Clara is at the home of her stepfather, but is shown as being married. The only record which provides anything of substance is the 1888 baptism entry for his daughter Sarah.

1881: In the census for this year, **Clara York** was 16 and a Cotton Weaver. She seems to be listed as the daughter of John Downward and his wife Nancy. They were boarding at the home of Mary Wolstencroft, a widow, aged 70, of 221 Lumber Lane.

1886: **Robert Proud** married **Clara Yorke** in 3rd qtr. of 1886.

1886: 4th qtr. Birth of Mary Proud at Barton.

1888: Baptism of Sarah Proud, to **Robert** and **Clara Proud**, on 10 October **1888** at St. Mark's Worsley. Their address was Shaving Lane and Robert was a Sinker.
