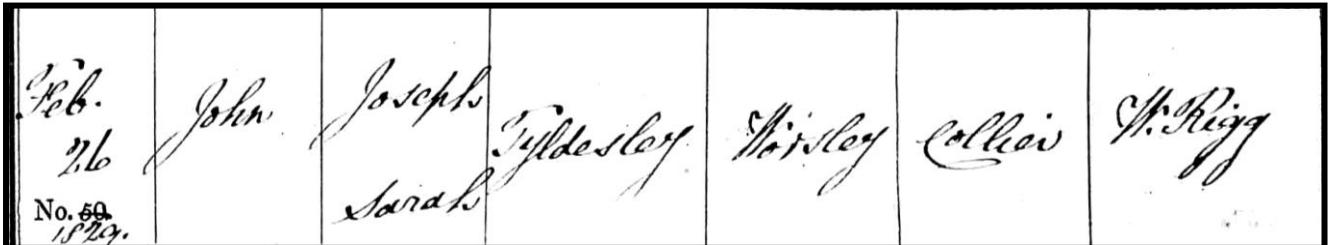

**1865:** Marriage of **Joseph Tyldesley** and **Harriet Whittaker** by Register's Certificate at St. Mark's on 10 July **1865**. His father had been a Collier and had died 7 years earlier. [Under current legislation, if you are a national of the UK, but wish to marry in a church with which you have no pre-existing legally-recognised connection, but are able to live in the parish for at least seven days in order to qualify to be married in the parish church, then you must apply for a Registrar's Certificate. This seems curious in this case, since they were resident here in the 1861 census].
