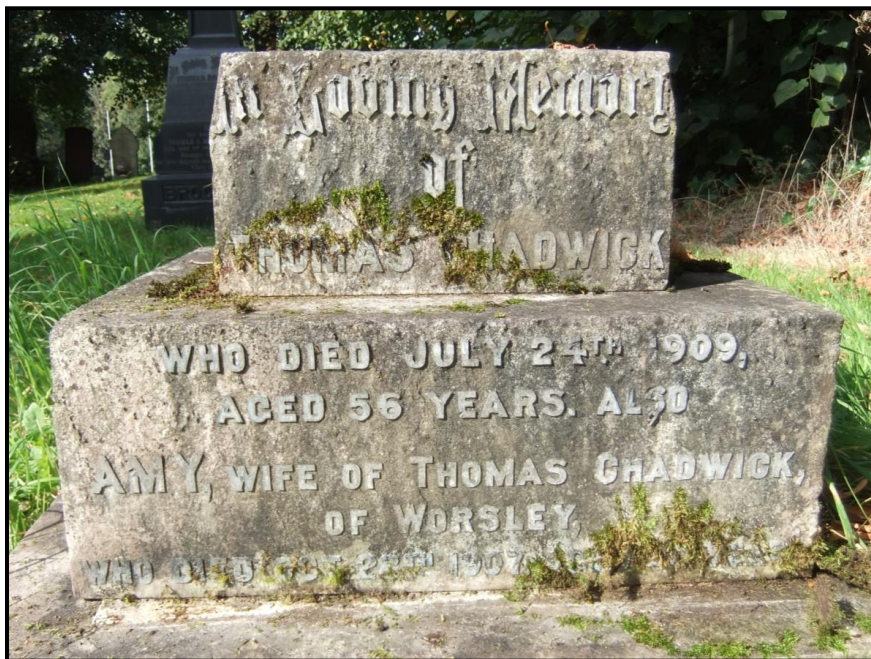

Thomas and Amy had another son, Gilbert, who was baptised at St. Mark's on 2 September **1903** (born 6 June), about 2 months after his birth on 6 June **1903**. The home address was 9 Worsley Road and the father's occupation was Carrier's Agent.

All the 4 children mentioned in the census above were baptised on the same day at St. Mark's on 7 August **1894**. Caroline was born on 18 March 1881; Thomas Arthur on 22 August 1882; Edith Dorothy on 27 June 1884; and Herbert on 3 February 1887.

The Will with three Codicils of Thomas Chadwick late of Runcorn in the County of **Chester** Coal Merchant who died 5 June 1883 at Runcorn was proved at **Chester** by David Henry Chadwick of 163 Broad-street Pendleton in the County of Lancaster Provision Dealer and Thomas Chadwick of 10 Parran-lane Monton near Patricroft in the County of Lancaster Merchant's Clerk the Sons and William Handley of 63 Bridge-street Runcorn Shoemaker the Executors.

As for Martha Chadwick, she appeared in 3 further censuses (1891, 1901 and 1911) and all at the same address in Bridgewater Street, Runcorn. Her death was recorded in early **1918** in Runcorn at the age of 97!
